1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2023 Supplement, section 624.712, subdivision 5, is amended
1.7 to read:

1.8 Subd. 5. Crime of violence. "Crime of violence" means: felony convictions of the
1.9 following offenses: sections 518B.01, subdivision 14 (violation of an order for protection);

2.5 6 (violation of a restraining order); 609.749 (harassment); 609.855, subdivision 5 (shooting
2.6 at a public transit vehicle or facility); 629.75, subdivision 2 (violation of a domestic abuse
2.7 no contact order); and chapter 152 (drugs, controlled substances); and an attempt to commit
2.8 any of these offenses.
