1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to agriculture; reducing noncommercial pesticide applicator license fee  
1.3 for certain persons; amending Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 18B.34, subdivision  
1.4 5.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 18B.34, subdivision 5, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 5. **Fees.** (a) A person initially applying for or renewing a noncommercial applicator  
1.8 license must pay a nonrefundable application fee of \$50, except an applicant who ~~is~~ uses  
1.9 pesticides in the course of performing official duties as: (1) a government employee; (2) a  
1.10 contractor providing rest area custodial services for the commissioner of transportation; or  
1.11 (3) a Conservation Corps Minnesota employee who uses pesticides in the course of  
1.12 performing official duties must pay a nonrefundable application fee of \$10.

1.13 (b) A license renewal application received after March 1 in the year for which the license  
1.14 is to be issued is subject to a penalty fee of 50 percent of the application fee. The penalty  
1.15 fee must be paid before the renewal license may be issued.

1.16 (c) An application for a duplicate noncommercial applicator license must be accompanied  
1.17 by a nonrefundable application fee of \$10.
