1.7	(a) \$7,389,506 in fiscal year 2020 is appropriated from the Help America Vote Act
1.8	(HAVA) account established in Minnesota Statutes, section 5.30, to the secretary of state
1.9	for the purposes of improving the administration and security of elections as authorized by
1.10	federal law, including but not limited to any of the following activities:
1.11	(1) modernizing, securing, and updating the statewide voter registration system and for
1.12	cybersecurity upgrades as authorized by federal law;
1.13	(2) improving accessibility;
1.14	(3) preparing training materials and training local election officials;
1.15	(4) implementing security improvements for election systems; and
1.16	(5) funding other activities to improve the security of elections.
