1.7	Subd. 5. Employee. "Employee" means any person who is employed by an employer,
1.8	including temporary and part-time employees, who performs work for at least 80 hours in
1.9	a year for that employer in Minnesota. Employee does not include:
1.10	(1) an independent contractor; or.
1.11	(2) an individual employed by an air carrier as a flight deck or cabin crew member who:
1.12	(i) is subject to United States Code, title 45, sections 181 to 188;
1.13	(ii) works less than a majority of their hours in Minnesota in a calendar year; and
1.14	(iii) is provided with paid leave equal to or exceeding the amounts in section 181.9446.
