1.6	Section 1. [200.025] RANKED-CHOICE VOTING; PROHIBITION.
1.7	(a) The following political subdivisions may not adopt or enforce in any manner a rule,
1.8	resolution, or ordinance establishing ranked-choice voting as a method of voting, or any
1.9	voting method similar to ranked-choice voting, for local offices within the political
1.10	subdivision:
1.11	(1) home rule charter or statutory cities;
1.12	(2) counties;
1.13	(3) townships; and
1.14	(4) school districts.
1.15	(b) For purposes of this section, "ranked-choice voting" means any election method in
1.16	which a voter ranks or assigns a numerical value to candidates for an office in order of the
