1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. NOBLES COUNTY RESOURCE CENTER.
1.6	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$26,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.7	fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to Nobles
1.8	County for design, engineering, and construction of the Nobles County Resource Center
1.9	on the site of the former Campbell's Soup facility in the city of Worthington. The new
1.10	facility shall provide space for Nobles County and Independent School District No. 518,
1.11	Worthington, and shall provide library and human services support functions, as well as
1.12	community education, integration, and a welcome center for new residents to the region.
1.13	This appropriation is available when the commissioner of management and budget determines
1.14	that sufficient resources have been committed to complete the project, as required by
1.15	Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.502.
1.16	Subd. 2. <b>Bond sale.</b> To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
1.17	proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
1.18	the state in an amount up to \$26,000,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
1.19	prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
1.20	Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
1.21	<b>EFFECTIVE DATE.</b> This section is effective the day following final enactment.
