1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to public safety; appropriating money to match federal disaster assistance  
1.3 made available through FEMA Public Assistance Program.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **APPROPRIATION.**

1.6 \$3,691,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of public  
1.7 safety to provide a match for Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) disaster  
1.8 assistance to state agencies and political subdivisions under Minnesota Statutes, section  
1.9 12.221, in the area designated under Presidential Declaration of Major Disaster, for the  
1.10 flooding in Minnesota in the spring of 2010, whether included in the original declaration  
1.11 or added later by federal government action. This is a onetime appropriation. This  
1.12 appropriation does not lapse.

1.13 Sec. 2. **APPROPRIATIONS MADE ONLY ONCE.**

1.14 If the appropriations made in this act are enacted more than once in the 2010 regular  
1.15 session, these appropriations must be given effect only once.

1.16 Sec. 3. **EFFECTIVE DATE.**

1.17 Sections 1 and 2 are effective the day following final enactment.
