1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to environment; requiring a report on state agency salt purchases and
1.3 establishing reduction goal; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes,
1.4 chapter 116.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. [116.2021] STATE SALT PURCHASE REPORT AND REDUCTION
1.7 GOAL.

1.8 Subdivision 1. Definition. For the purposes of this section, "deicing salt" refers to salt
1.9 in its solid form used to melt snow and ice, excluding salt used on roads managed by the
1.10 Department of Transportation.

1.11 Subd. 2. Salt purchase report. By February 1, 2025, and every year thereafter, the
1.12 commissioner of the Pollution Control Agency, in cooperation with other state agencies,
1.13 must submit a report to the legislative committees and divisions with jurisdiction over
1.14 environment and natural resources policy and finance that details the purchase of deicing
1.15 salt by state agencies, excluding the Department of Transportation, and strategies to meet
1.16 the salt reduction goal established in subdivision 3.

1.17 Subd. 3. Reduction goal. It is the goal of the state that no later than January 1, 2030,
1.18 state agencies will reduce the purchase of deicing salt by 25 percent from the level first
1.19 reported under subdivision 2.
