1.8 Subd. 40. Prescription for opiate antagonist. When determining whether to issue,  
1.9 renew, cancel, or modify a policy of life insurance, an insurer may not make an underwriting  
1.10 determination based solely on information revealing that a proposed insured has a prescription  
1.11 for an opiate antagonist, as defined in section 604A.04, subdivision 1.
