1.5	Section 1. RED RIVER BASIN FLOOD DAMAGE REDUCTION PROJECTS.
1.6	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. (a) \$73,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.7	fund to the commissioner of natural resources for the state share of flood hazard mitigation
1.8	grants for publicly owned capital improvements to prevent or alleviate flood damage under
1.9	Minnesota Statutes, section 103F.161, subdivision 3, and to enhance natural resources.
1.10	Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 103F.161, subdivision 2, a grant for
1.11	implementation of a flood hazard mitigation project in the Red River basin, consistent with
1.12	the 1998 mediation agreement and approved by the Red River flood damage reduction work
