Supporting data do not include preliminary draft proposals 1.10 created and presented during the development of the budget presented to the governing 1.11 body. A city may disclose any of the data within the city's administration and to the public 1.12 at any time if disclosure would aid the city in considering and preparing its proposals. 1.13
