1.9	paraphernalia" means all equipment, products, and materials of any kind, except those items
1.10	used in conjunction with permitted uses of controlled substances under this chapter or the
1.11	Uniform Controlled Substances Act, which are knowingly or intentionally used primarily
1.12	in (1) manufacturing a controlled substance, (2) injecting, ingesting, inhaling, or otherwise
1.13	introducing into the human body a controlled substance, (3) testing the strength, effectiveness,
1.14	or purity of a controlled substance, or (4) enhancing the effect of a controlled substance.
1.15	(b) "Drug paraphernalia" does not include the possession, manufacture, delivery, or sale
