OFFICIAL STATUS

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to education finance; authorizing a fund transfer for Independent School
1.3 District No. 191, Burnsville-Eagan-Savage.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **FUND TRANSFER; BURNSVILLE-EAGAN-SAVAGE SCHOOL**
1.6 **DISTRICT.**

1.7 (a) Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 123B.51, subdivision 4, paragraph (b),
1.8 or any law to the contrary, any remaining net proceeds received by the district in connection
1.9 with a lease of real property that is not needed for school purposes, or part of the property
1.10 that is not needed for school purposes as permitted under Minnesota Statutes, section
1.11 123B.51, subdivision 4, paragraph (a), and which the school board of Independent School
1.12 District No. 191, Burnsville-Eagan-Savage, specifically identified in the district's open
1.13 facilities action plan, may be deposited in the district's general unrestricted fund following
1.14 the deposit of such proceeds, as required under Minnesota Statutes, section 123B.51,
1.15 subdivision 4, paragraph (b).

1.16 (b) Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 123B.51, subdivision 6, paragraphs (c)
1.17 to (f), or any law to the contrary, any remaining proceeds of the sale or exchange of school
1.18 buildings or real property of Independent School District No. 191, Burnsville-Eagan-Savage,
1.19 specifically identified in the district's open facilities action plan may be deposited in the
1.20 district's general unrestricted fund following application of such proceeds, as required under
1.21 Minnesota Statutes, section 123B.51, subdivision 6, paragraph (b).
