1.9	(2) supplies necessary for participation in any instructional course except as authorized
1.10	in sections 123B.36 and 123B.38;
1.11	(3) field trips that are required as a part of a basic education program or course;
1.12	(4) graduation caps, gowns, any specific form of dress necessary for any educational
1.13	program, and diplomas;
1.14	(5) instructional costs for necessary school personnel employed in any course or
1.15	educational program required for graduation;
1.16	(6) library books required to be utilized for any educational course or program;
