1.5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.6	Section 1. APPROPRIATION; CAMP FIRE MINNESOTA.
1.7	\$1,090,000 in fiscal year 2024 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner
1.8	of employment and economic development for a grant to Camp Fire Minnesota, a 501(c)(3)
1.9	nonprofit organization, to build a new bathhouse in the day camp area; build a new year-round
1.10	program building for the day camp area; build new day camp shelters; build a new boating
1.11	area at the waterfront; pave the road and parking area on the property; complete an erosion
1.12	control project at the waterfront; and purchase a 15-passenger van for transportation. This
1.13	appropriation is available until the project is completed or abandoned, subject to Minnesota
1.14	Statutes, section 16A.642. This is a onetime appropriation.
