OFFICIAL STATUS

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to public safety; regulating participation in federal law enforcement task
1.3 forces; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 626.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **[626.97] PARTICIPATION IN FEDERAL TASK FORCES.**

1.6 (a) No state or local law enforcement agency may participate in a federal or other
1.7 multijurisdictional law enforcement task force if the task force prohibits its members from
1.8 being equipped with and using a body-worn camera.

1.9 (b) A peace officer, as defined in section 626.84, subdivision 1, shall be equipped with
1.10 and use a body-worn camera when participating in a federal or other multijurisdictional law
1.11 enforcement task force.

1.12 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
