Acceptable projects under this section include, but are not limited to, upgrading arts education facilities and equipment to reduce environmental impact, disposing of toxic or environmentally hazardous arts education materials, disposing of paint or other art mediums, and purchasing environmentally responsible arts education materials. The grant money must only be used to design, acquire, construct, expand, remodel, improve, furnish, service, maintain, or equip arts education facilities according to the requirements of this section.
