Except as provided in subdivision 1.7 3, the membership terms, compensation, removal of members, and filling of vacancies on 1.8 the board are governed by section 15.0575. 1.9 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 35.02, is amended by adding a subdivision to 1.10 read: 1.11 Subd. 3. Livestock producer board members. For purposes of this section, "producer 1.12 of livestock" and "livestock producer" mean a person who earned at least \$78,000 of the 1.13 person's annual gross sales from the sale of livestock during the previous calendar year.
