OFFICIAL STATUS

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to state government; prohibiting imposition of additional penalties to a
1.3 business for violation of certain executive orders.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **VIOLATION OF EXECUTIVE ORDERS DURING A PEACETIME**
1.6 **EMERGENCY.**

1.7 Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, no board or licensing agency may impose
1.8 additional penalties to a business for a violation of Executive Order 20-04, as extended,
1.9 amended, and otherwise modified by Executive Order 20-08, Executive Order 20-18,
1.10 Executive Order 20-33, and any related executive orders issued pursuant to Minnesota
1.11 Statutes, section 12.21 or 12.31.

1.12 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
