1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **VIOLATION OF EXECUTIVE ORDERS DURING A PEACETIME**

1.6 **EMERGENCY.**

1.7 Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, no board or agency, including agencies

1.8 that issue licenses, may impose additional penalties on a business for a violation of an

1.9 executive order issued in response to the spread of COVID-19, pursuant to Minnesota

1.10 Statutes, section 12.21 or 12.31, beyond the penalties imposed by the executive orders.

1.11 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
