1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 97B.731, subdivision 3, is amended to read:
1.6	Subd. 3. Crow season. The commissioner shall prescribe a 124-day open season and
1.7	restrictions seasons for taking crows are January 1 through January 15, March 15 through
1.8	March 31, and August 1 through October 31. The open season may not be shorter than the
1.9	maximum season allowed under federal law. The remainder of the year, crows may be taken
1.10	as allowed by federal law.
