1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 504B.212, is amended by adding a subdivision

1.8	Subd. 2a. Criminal history background check; nonresident tenant organizers. A
1.9	landlord may request a criminal history background check from the superintendent of the
1.10	Bureau of Criminal Apprehension for a tenant organizer who is not a resident at the premises
1.11	before the tenant organizer enters the premises or exercises any rights under this section.
1.12	The tenant organizer must complete a criminal history consent form and provide payment
1.13	to the landlord in an amount equal to the actual cost to the landlord for conducting the
1.14	criminal history background check. A landlord may prohibit a tenant organizer from entering
1.15	the premises or exercising the rights under this section if:
1.16	(1) the tenant organizer was convicted of a crime of violence, as defined in section
1.17	624.712, subdivision 5; or
1.18	(2) the tenant organizer refuses to consent to a criminal history background check.
