1.7	Health to assess the threats posed to Minnesota pets and people by flea and tick collars that
1.8	contain pesticide. The Board of Animal Health must consult the commissioners of agriculture,
1.9	health, and the Pollution Control Agency and report recommendations to the legislative
1.10	committees with jurisdiction over agriculture, health, and the environment no later than
1.11	February 1, 2022.
