1.7	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 123B.595, subdivision 1, is amended to read:
1.8	Subdivision 1. Long-term facilities maintenance revenue. (a) For fiscal year 2017
1.9	only, long-term facilities maintenance revenue equals the greater of (1) the sum of (i) \$193
1.10	times the district's adjusted pupil units times the lesser of one or the ratio of the district's
1.11	average building age to 35 years, plus the cost approved by the commissioner for indoor
1.12	air quality, fire alarm and suppression, and asbestos abatement projects under section
1.13	123B.57, subdivision 6, with an estimated cost of \$100,000 or more per site, plus (ii) for a

(c) For fiscal year 2019 and later, (a) Long-term facilities maintenance revenue equals 2.11 the greater of (1) the sum of (i) \$380 times the district's adjusted pupil units times the lesser 2.12 of one or the ratio of the district's average building age to 35 years, plus (ii) the cost approved 2.13 by the commissioner for indoor air quality, fire alarm and suppression, and asbestos 2.14 abatement projects under section 123B.57, subdivision 6, with an estimated cost of \$100,000 2.15 or more per site, plus (iii) for a school district with an approved voluntary prekindergarten 2.16 program under section 124D.151, the cost approved by the commissioner for remodeling 2.17 existing instructional space to accommodate prekindergarten instruction, or (2) the sum of 2.18 (i) the amount the district would have qualified for under Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 2.19 123B.57, Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 123B.59, and Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 2.20 123B.591, and (ii) for a school district with an approved voluntary prekindergarten program 2.21 under section 124D.151, the cost approved by the commissioner for remodeling existing 2.22 instructional space to accommodate prekindergarten instruction. 2.23

(b) In addition to the revenue authorized in paragraph (a), a school district operating a
 school building enrolling students listed on the National Register of Historic Places is eligible
 for additional long-term facilities maintenance revenue equal to \$...... times the district's
 adjusted pupil units for that year.

- (d) (c) Notwithstanding paragraphs (a), (b), and (c) (b), a school district that qualified
  for eligibility under Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 123B.59, subdivision 1, paragraph
  (a), for fiscal year 2010 remains eligible for funding under this section as a district that
  would have qualified for eligibility under Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 123B.59,
  subdivision 1, paragraph (a), for fiscal year 2017 and later.
