1.8	state college or university for use in satisfying credit requirements for a degree, diploma,
1.9	or certificate. Among other policies, the board may adopt policies accepting those
1.10	credits for the purpose of meeting general education credits or other distribution credit

- 1.11 requirements. The policies must apply regardless of whether the credits were earned in a
- 1.12 <u>degree, diploma, or certificate program.</u>
