1.1 A bill for an act

1.2 relating to human services; increasing medical assistance reimbursement rates for

1.3 doula services; amending Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 256B.758.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 256B.758, is amended to read:

1.6 **256B.758 REIMBURSEMENT FOR DOULA SERVICES.**

1.7 (a) Effective for services provided on or after July 1, 2019, payments for doula services

1.8 provided by a certified doula shall be \$47 per prenatal or postpartum visit and \$488 for

1.9 attending and providing doula services at a birth.

1.10 (b) Effective for services provided on or after July 1, 2023, payments for doula services

1.11 provided by a certified doula are \$100 per prenatal or postpartum visit, up to a total of six

1.12 visits, and \$1,400 for attending and providing doula services at birth.

1.13 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective July 1, 2023.
