OFFICIAL STATUS

- 1.1 A bill for an act
- 1.2 relating to transportation; repealing requirement to retire type III vehicles after 12
- 1.3 years; repealing Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 169.454, subdivision 2.
- 1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5 Section 1. **REPEALER.**
- 1.6 Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 169.454, subdivision 2, is repealed.
- 1.7 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.

169.454 TYPE III VEHICLE STANDARDS.

Subd. 2. **Age of vehicle.** Vehicles 12 years or older must not be used as type III vehicles to transport school children, except those vehicles that are manufactured to meet the structural requirements of federal motor vehicle safety standard 222, Code of Federal Regulations, title 49, part 571.
