1.9	Communities United in Service (CLUES) to expand culturally tailored programs that
1.10	address employment and education skill gaps for working parents and underserved
1.11	youth. The appropriation shall fund programs that provide new job skills training to
1.12	stimulate higher wages for low-income people, family support systems designed to reduce
1.13	generational poverty, and youth programming to promote educational advancement and
1.14	career pathways. At least \$500,000 of the total appropriation must be used for programming
1.15	targeted at greater Minnesota. CLUES shall submit a report to the chairs and ranking
