1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to medical cannabis; providing that a person under correctional supervision
1.3 may participate in the medical cannabis program without facing sanctions;
1.4 amending Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 152.32, by adding a subdivision.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 152.32, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.7 to read:

1.8 Subd. 4. Probation; supervised release. (a) A court may not prohibit a person from
1.9 participating in the registry program under sections 152.22 to 152.37 as a condition of
1.10 probation or revoke a patient's probation or otherwise sanction a patient on probation solely
1.11 for participating in the registry program or for a positive drug test for cannabis components
1.12 or metabolites.

1.13 (b) The commissioner of corrections may not prohibit a person from participating in the
1.14 registry program under sections 152.22 to 152.37 as a condition of parole, supervised release,
1.15 or conditional release or revoke a patient's parole, supervised release, or conditional release
1.16 or otherwise sanction a patient on parole, supervised release, or conditional release solely
1.17 for participating in the registry program or for a positive drug test for cannabis components
1.18 or metabolites.
