	Section 1. MARKED U.S. HIGHWAY 10 STRATEGIC CONGESTION
	MITIGATION.
	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$25,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
	account in the trunk highway fund to the commissioner of transportation for a grant to Anoka
	County to complete the preliminary engineering, environmental documentation, final design,
	right-of-way acquisition, construction, and construction administration of a third travel lane
	in each direction of marked U.S. Highway 10 from east of the interchange with Hanson
	Boulevard to Round Lake Boulevard in the city of Coon Rapids. This appropriation does
	not require a nonstate contribution.
	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in subdivision 1 from the bond
	proceeds account in the trunk highway fund, the commissioner of management and budget
	shall sell and issue bonds of the state in an amount up to \$25,000,000 in the manner, upon
	the terms, and with the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 167.50 to 167.52,
	and by the Minnesota Constitution, article XIV, section 11, at the times and in the amounts
	requested by the commissioner of transportation. The proceeds of the bonds, except accrued
	interest and any premium received from the sale of the bonds, must be deposited in the bond
	proceeds account in the trunk highway fund.
