1.11	Subd. 11. Area learning center transportation aid. (a) A district that provides
1.12	transportation of pupils to and from an area learning center program established under
1.13	section 123A.05 is eligible for state aid to reimburse the additional costs of transportation
1.14	during the preceding fiscal year. For the purposes of this subdivision, "district" includes a
1.15	school district, intermediate school district, or other cooperative unit under section 123A.24,
1.16	subdivision 2.
1.17	(b) A district may apply to the commissioner of education for state aid to reimburse the
1.18	costs of transporting pupils who are enrolled in an area learning center program established
1.19	under section 123A.05 during the preceding fiscal year. The commissioner shall develop
1.20	the form and manner of applications for state aid, the criteria to determine when transportation
1.21	is necessary, and the accounting procedure to determine excess costs. In determining aid
1.22	amounts, the commissioner shall consider other revenue received by the district for
1.23	transportation for area learning center purposes.
