1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to liquor; authorizing the issuance of malt liquor and wine licenses to
1.3 certain retailers currently licensed to sell 3.2 beer.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **EXISTING 3.2 PERCENT MALT LIQUOR LICENSES.**

1.6 (a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, by the effective date of this section, the
1.7 governing body of a city or county shall issue to a person that is currently licensed under
1.8 Minnesota Statutes, section 340A.403, subdivision 1, for the on-sale of 3.2 percent malt
1.9 liquor, a license for the on-sale of malt liquor and a license for the on-sale of wine.

1.10 (b) All other provisions of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 340A, not inconsistent with this
1.11 section, apply to the issuance of a license under this section.
