1.14	advanced telecommunications services for end users.
1.15	(d) "Commissioner" means the commissioner of employment and economic development.
1.16	(e) "Last-mile infrastructure" means broadband infrastructure that serves as the final leg
1.17	connecting the broadband service provider's network to the end-use customer's on-premises
1.18	telecommunications equipment.
1.19	(f) "Middle-mile infrastructure" means broadband infrastructure that links a broadband
1.20	service provider's core network infrastructure to last-mile infrastructure.
