1.8	building facade grant pilot program to provide grants to cities that meet the eligibility criteria

1.10	the cities of Litchfield and Virginia. Each city grantee may receive no more than \$2,500,000
1.11	in total pilot program grants.
1.12	Subd. 2. Eligibility. Eligible city grantees must have:
1.13	(1) a population of less than 15,000; and
1.14	(2) a commercial historic district listed on the National Register of Historic Places.
1.15	Subd. 3. Grant agreements. (a) A city grantee under this section must enter into grant
1.16	agreements with owners of properties in the city that:
1.17	(1) are located within the boundaries of the commercial historic district; and
1.18	(2) have facades that are historic in nature.
1.19	(b) A property owner grantee under this subdivision must use the money to rehabilitate
