3.2	meetings must be recorded and available to the public on the website of the Department of

3.4	Subd. 4. Staff; meeting space. The commissioner of corrections shall provide support
3.5	staff, office and meeting space, and administrative services for the task force.
3.6	Subd. 5. Duties. The task force shall evaluate the viability of the state correctional
3.7	facilities located in St. Cloud and Stillwater including an assessment of potential costs,
3.8	benefits, and impacts of both repairing and replacing the correctional facilities.
3.9	Subd. 6. <b>Report.</b> The task force must file a report with the commissioner of corrections
3.10	and the chairs and ranking minority members of the senate and house of representatives
3.11	committees and divisions with jurisdiction over public safety and capital investment on the
3.12	evaluation completed under subdivision 5 on or before February 1, 2025.
3.13	Subd. 7. Expiration. The task force expires the day after submitting its report under

subdivision 6. 3.14
