1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to motor vehicles; drivers' licenses; establishing a full-service office by
1.3 authorizing the appointment of a driver's license agent at the Hmong Village
1.4 Shopping Center in the city of St. Paul; amending Laws 2023, chapter 68, article
1.5 4, section 108.

1.6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.7 Section 1. Laws 2023, chapter 68, article 4, section 108, is amended to read:

1.8 **Sec. 108. ADDITIONAL DEPUTY REGISTRAR OF MOTOR VEHICLES FOR**
1.9 **RAMSEY COUNTY.**

1.10 Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, ~~section~~ sections 168.33 and 171.061, and rules
1.11 adopted by the commissioner of public safety limiting sites for the office of deputy registrar
1.12 or driver's license agent based on either the distance to an existing deputy registrar or driver's
1.13 license agent office or the annual volume of transactions processed by any deputy registrar
1.14 or driver's license agent within Ramsey County before or after the proposed appointment,
1.15 the commissioner of public safety must appoint a new private deputy registrar of motor
1.16 vehicles and driver's license agent to operate a new full-service office ~~of deputy registrar~~,
1.17 with full authority to function as a registration and motor vehicle tax collection bureau or
1.18 driver's license agent bureau, at or in the vicinity of the Hmong Village shopping center at
1.19 1001 Johnson Parkway in the city of St. Paul. The addition of a driver's license agent
1.20 establishes the Hmong Village Shopping Center location as a full-service office with full
1.21 authority to function as a registration and motor vehicle tax collection and driver's license
1.22 bureau. All other provisions regarding the appointment and operation of a deputy registrar
1.23 of motor vehicles and driver's license agent under Minnesota Statutes, ~~section~~ sections

2.1 168.33 and 171.061, and Minnesota Rules, ~~chapter~~ chapters 7404 and 7406, apply to the
2.2 office.

2.3 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
