OFFICIAL STATUS

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to health; establishing a grant program for a seizure detection device public
1.3 awareness campaign; appropriating money.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **PROGRAM ESTABLISHED; SEIZURE DETECTION DEVICE**
1.6 **CAMPAIGN.**

1.7 The commissioner of health shall establish a grant program to promote a seizure detection
1.8 device public awareness campaign. The commissioner must award grants under this program
1.9 to a statewide epilepsy advocacy organization that will disseminate information on coverage
1.10 of seizure detection devices under Minnesota's medical assistance program and how eligible
1.11 individuals can obtain the device. The organization receiving funds for the public awareness
1.12 campaign under this section must perform awareness-raising activities, including but not
1.13 limited to training, outreach events including culturally specific events and virtual events,
1.14 social media and multichannel marketing, press releases, briefings, and commentaries.

1.15 Sec. 2. **APPROPRIATION; SEIZURE DETECTION DEVICE CAMPAIGN.**

1.16 \$..... in fiscal year 2025 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of
1.17 health for a grant program to promote a seizure detection device public awareness campaign.
1.18 This is a onetime appropriation and is available until June 30, 2030.
