[116.063] PRIORITIZATION OF AIR QUALITY INVESTMENTS; 1.5 **BUSES.** 16 (a) The Metropolitan Council must deploy buses with the lowest air emissions in areas 1.7 with poor air quality. 1.8 (b) For the purposes of this section, "poor air quality" means: 1.9 (1) ambient air levels of total suspended particulates, particulate matter less than ten 1.10 microns wide (PM-10), particulate matter less than 2.5 microns wide (PM-2.5), sulfur 1.11 dioxide, or nitrogen dioxide, as revealed by air monitoring data, that approach or exceed 1.12 state or federal air quality standards or chronic health inhalation risk benchmarks; or 1.13 (2) levels of asthma among children that significantly exceed the statewide average. 1.14 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment. 1.15
