1.6	Section 1. DENTAL HOME PILOT PROJECT.
1.7	Subdivision 1. Establishment; requirements. (a) The commissioner of human services
1.8	shall establish a dental home pilot project to increase access of medical assistance and
1.9	MinnesotaCare enrollees to dental care, improve patient experience, and improve oral health
1.10	clinical outcomes, in a manner that sustains the financial viability of the dental workforce
1.11	and broader dental care delivery and financing system. Dental homes must provide
1.12	high-quality, patient-centered, comprehensive, and coordinated oral health services across
1.13	clinical and community-based settings, including virtual oral health care.
1.14	(b) The design and operation of the dental home pilot project must be consistent with
1.15	the recommendations made by the Dental Services Advisory Committee to the legislature
1.16	under Laws 2021, First Special Session chapter 7, article 1, section 33.
1.17	(c) The commissioner shall establish baseline requirements and performance measures
1.18	for dental homes participating in the pilot project. These baseline requirements and
1.19	performance measures must address access and patient experience and oral health clinical
1.20	outcomes.
