1.9	or equivalent, on the side of the can or bottle, and does not require a similar disclosure on
1.10	the can top. The commissioner shall establish standards to implement this requirement.
1.11	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective on July 1, 2017, and applies to all cans
1.12	or bottles sold after that date.
