1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to natural resources; modifying wild rice harvesting provisions; amending  
1.3 Minnesota Statutes 2020, sections 84.091, subdivision 2; 84.111, subdivision 4.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 84.091, subdivision 2, is amended to read:

1.6 Subd. 2. **License required; exemptions.** (a) Except as provided in this subdivision, a  
1.7 person may not harvest, buy, sell, transport, or possess aquatic plants without a license  
1.8 required under this chapter. A license shall be issued in the same manner as provided under  
1.9 the game and fish laws.

1.10 (b) A resident under the age of 18 years may harvest wild rice without a license, ~~if~~  
1.11 ~~accompanied by a person with a wild-rice license.~~

1.12 (c) Tribal band members who possess a valid tribal identification card from a federally  
1.13 recognized tribe located in Minnesota are deemed to have a license to harvest wild rice  
1.14 under this section.

1.15 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.

1.16 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 84.111, subdivision 4, is amended to read:

1.17 Subd. 4. **Harvest hours.** ~~It is unlawful to~~ A person may not harvest any wild rice in any  
1.18 public waters between 3:00 p.m. one-half hour after sunset and 9:00 a.m. following except  
1.19 as otherwise expressly permitted in writing by an authorized committee member or other  
1.20 agent of the commissioner pursuant to rules of the commissioner.

1.21 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
