| 1.8 | (a) The commissioner may, by rule, prescribe restrictions and designate areas where |
| 1.9 | deer may be taken, including hunter selection criteria for special hunts established under |
| 1.10 | section 97A.401, subdivision 4. The commissioner may, by rule, prescribe the open seasons |
| 1.11 | for deer to begin no later than noon on a Friday within the following periods: |
| 1.12 | (1) taking with firearms, other than muzzle-loading firearms, between November 1 and |
| 1.13 | December 15; |
| 1.14 | (2) taking with muzzle-loading firearms between September 1 and December 31; and |
