1.5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.6	Section 1. PILOT PROJECTS FOR COUNTIES TO IMPROVE DYNAMIC
1.7	TRANSPORTATION OPTIONS; GRANTS.
1.8	(a) The commissioner of transportation must establish a program to award grants to five
1.9	to ten counties to fund pilot projects that improve dynamic transportation options for
1.10	residents. The commissioner must establish a process for counties to apply for a grant under
1.11	this section and a process for selecting the projects. The projects must be selected and the
1.12	grants awarded by December 1, 2024.
1.13	(b) The commissioner must select pilot projects that:
1.14	(1) improve access to nonfixed route transportation options;
1.15	(2) allow for flexibility in scheduling rides; and
1.16	(3) leverage existing programs, resources, or private sector businesses in the county.
