Section 1. 1 personnel aid, the aid may be used for contracted services from individuals licensed to serve as a school counselor, school psychologist, school social worker, school nurse, or chemical dependency counselor in Minnesota.

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(d) Notwithstanding paragraphs (a) and (c), a declining enrollment district may use aid under this section to maintain existing student support services personnel positions or contracted services, including positions or contracted services established prior to the 2023-2024 school year. For purposes of this paragraph, "declining enrollment district" means a school district or charter school for which the enrollment on October 1 of the previous fiscal year is less than the enrollment on October 1 of the second previous fiscal year. A school district or charter school that qualifies as a declining enrollment district under this paragraph remains eligible to allocate aid as provided under this paragraph for each of the next four fiscal years.

2.13 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective for revenue in fiscal year 2025 and later.
