1.7 Subd. 2. **Uses.** (a) Money allocated to counties and Tribes may be used for the following

1.8 purposes:

1.9 (1) to implement or expand any service or program that is included in the state's

1.10 prevention plan;

1.11 (2) to implement or expand any proposed service or program;

1.12 (3) to implement or expand any existing service or program; and

1.13 (4) any other use approved by the commissioner.

1.14 (b) A county or a Tribe must use at least ten percent of the allocation to provide services

1.15 and supports directly to families.
