Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 297A.67, is amended by adding a subdivision 1.5 to read: 1.6 Subd. 41. **School supplies.** (a) All school supplies are exempt. 1.7 (b) For the purposes of this section, "school supplies" includes but is not limited to 18 binders, calculators, cellophane tape, blackboard chalk, compasses, composition books, 1.9 crayons, erasers, folders, glue, paste, glue sticks, highlighters, index cards, index card boxes, 1.10 legal pads, lunch boxes, markers, notebooks, poster board, construction paper, graph paper, 1.11 tracing paper, manila paper, copy paper, loose-leaf ruled paper, colored paper, pencil boxes, 1.12 school supply boxes, pencil sharpeners, pencils, pens, protractors, rulers, scissors, and 1.13 writing tablets.
