1.16	county.		
1.17	article IV, section 3, will read:		
1.18	Sec. 3. At its first session after each enumeration of the inhabitants of this state made		
1.19	by the authority of the United States, the legislature shall have the power to prescribe the		
1.20	bounds of congressional and legislative districts. Senators shall be chosen by single districts
