OFFICIAL STATUS

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to state government; appropriating money to study and recommend an
1.3 amendment to the Minnesota Constitution on human rights enforcement.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **APPROPRIATION; CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT.**

1.6 \$500,000 in fiscal year 2022 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner
1.7 of human rights to study and make recommendations for an amendment to the Minnesota
1.8 Constitution affirming the enforcement of human rights. The commissioner shall conduct
1.9 surveys and hold statewide community meetings for the purpose of educating communities
1.10 on the constitutional amendment and gauging community support for a constitutional
1.11 amendment. This is a onetime appropriation and is available until June 30, 2024.
