A bill for an act 1.1 relating to education finance; including elementary counseling services for 12 nonpublic pupils in nonpublic pupil aid; appropriating money; amending Minnesota 1.3 Statutes 2024, section 123B.44, subdivisions 1, 5, 6. 1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA: 1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 123B.44, subdivision 1, is amended to read: 1.6 Subdivision 1. Provided services. The commissioner of education shall promulgate 1.7 rules under the provisions of chapter 14 requiring each district or other intermediary service 1.8 area: (a) (1) to provide each year upon formal request by a specific date by or on behalf of 1.9 a nonpublic school pupil enrolled in a nonpublic school located in that district or area, the 1.10 same specific health services as are provided for public school pupils by the district where 1.11 the nonpublic school is located; and (b) (2) to provide each year upon formal request by a 1.12 specific date by or on behalf of a nonpublic school elementary or secondary pupil enrolled 1.13 in a nonpublic school located in that district or area, the same specific guidance and 1.14 counseling services as are provided for public school secondary pupils by the district where 1.15 the nonpublic school is located. The district where the nonpublic school is located must 1.16 provide the necessary transportation within the district boundaries between the nonpublic 1.17 school and a public school or neutral site for nonpublic school pupils who are provided 1.18 pupil support services under this section if the district elects to provide pupil support services 1.19 at a site other than the nonpublic school. Each request for pupil support services must set 1.20 forth the guidance and counseling or health services requested by or on behalf of all eligible 1.21 nonpublic school pupils enrolled in a given nonpublic school. No district or intermediary 1.22 service area must not expend an amount for these pupil support services which exceeds the 1.23 amount allotted to it under this section. 1.24
