- 2.3 <u>\$35,000,000 in fiscal year 2018 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner</u>
- 2.4 of employment and economic development for deposit in the border-to-border broadband
- 2.5 <u>fund account under Minnesota Statutes, section 116J.396, to award grants under that section.</u>
- 2.6 Of this appropriation, no more than \$5,000,000 may be used for grants to underserved areas.
- 2.7 This is a onetime appropriation.
